



Ebook help: Kindle

Borrowing from the South Jersey Audiobook and eBook Download Center

How to Check Out a Kindle eBook

Using any device with an Internet connection:

1. Click on the **Free Audiobooks and Ebooks** link at the library website (www.moorestownlibrary.org)
2. You can search for a title, author, subject, or keyword, or you can browse titles by subject
3. Click on **Menu** to browse a full list of titles by subject or genre.
4. A black book icon on the cover of an item indicates that it is available to borrow. If a greyed-out book icon appears, the item is currently unavailable to borrow, but you can place a hold on it.
5. Click the cover of the e-book you want and then click **Borrow**. Items already checked out will say Place a Hold.
6. Select **Moorestown Library** from the Library drop down menu. On the next page, type your library card number in the box, and click **Sign In**.
7. Click **Download** and then select Kindle book.* Click **Confirm & Get Kindle Book**.
8. You will be redirected to Amazon's website. Click the **Get library book** button to check out the book
9. Sign in to your **Amazon account** (or create one if needed).
10. Choose your Kindle device in the **Deliver to:** drop down menu
11. If your Kindle is connected to WiFi, the eBook will download wirelessly to "Home" and you can start reading!

Transferring a Kindle eBook to the Kindle (for older devices)

Although earlier Kindle models do not have WiFi, you can transfer Kindle Books from a PC to these Kindle models using a USB cable:

1. After you sign in to your Amazon account, choose Transfer via Computer from the Deliver to: dropdown list.
2. Under **Which Kindle will you transfer to?** select your Kindle from the drop-down menu
3. **Save** the file to a location that is easy to find again, such as the desktop
4. Connect your Kindle to your computer using the USB cable
5. Your Kindle will appear as an external USB drive on your PC
6. Move the download file into the **Documents** directory on the Kindle USB drive by clicking and dragging
7. You may have to eject your Kindle before the document appears in the Kindle home screen

* In addition to Kindle formatted e-books, you can read EPUB e-books on the Kindle Fire by downloading the OverDrive app from the Amazon Appstore.
