



Ebook help: NOOK (older NOOK tablets and readers)

Borrowing from the South Jersey Audiobook and eBook Download Center

Before you check out a book

You must have **Adobe Digital Editions** software installed and authorized with an Adobe ID. The first time you run Adobe Digital Editions, you are prompted to authorize the application by entering an Adobe ID.

1. Go to [adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com/products/digitaleditions/) on your personal computer and launch the Adobe Digital Editions installer.

2. Follow the instructions provided to install the software on your computer.
3. To get an Adobe ID, you can create one when prompted within Digital Editions as you authorize your computer.

How to check out a book for your NOOK

Using your personal computer (not a library computer) with an Internet connection:

1. Click on the **Free Audiobooks and Ebooks** link at the library website (www.moorestownlibrary.org)
2. You can search for a title, author, subject, or keyword, or you can browse titles by subject
3. Click on **Menu** to browse a full list of titles by subject or genre.
4. A black book icon on the cover of an item indicates that it is available to borrow. If a greyed-out book icon appears, the item is currently unavailable to borrow, but you can place a hold on it.
5. Click the cover of the e-book you want and then click **Borrow**. Items already checked out will say Place a Hold.
6. Select **Moorestown Library** from the Library drop down menu. On the next page, type your library card number in the box, and click **Sign In**.
7. Click **Download** and then select EPUB ebook. Click **Confirm & Download**.
8. A dialog box will appear, prompting you to open an .acsm file. Open the file with Adobe Digital Editions.
9. The ebook will appear in your Library under All Items, and also as part of the Borrowed category.

How to begin reading on your NOOK

1. Once the e-book appears in your Adobe Digital Editions Library, connect the NOOK to your computer using the USB cable. The first time you do this, you will have to authorize your NOOK with your Adobe ID to be able to transfer protected content to and from the Nook.
2. From the Library view in Adobe Digital Editions, click and drag a book from the right side of the pane to the left side where you will see your NOOK listed.
3. Disconnect your NOOK from your computer.
4. Press Menu button on your NOOK.
5. Press My Library on your NOOK, and select your eBook.
