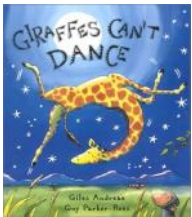
Pete the Cat is a fantastic fan favorite with stories often focused on friendship, sharing, positivity, and kindness! Grades K-3.

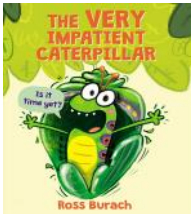
The kids in Room 207 take advantage of their teacher's good nature until she disappears and they are faced with a terrible substitute. Grades K-1.

by Giles Andreae

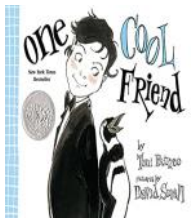
Gerald the giraffe is too clumsy to dance with all the other animals at the Jungle Dance, until he finds the right music. Grades K-1.

Elliot, a very proper young man, feels a kinship with the penguins at the aquarium and wants to take one home with him. Grades 1-3.

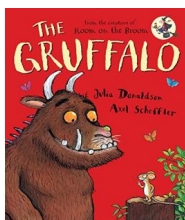

When Taylor's block castle is destroyed, all the animals think they know just what to do, but only the rabbit quietly listens to how Taylor is feeling. Grades K-1.

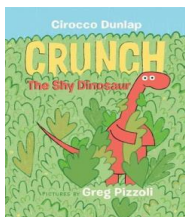

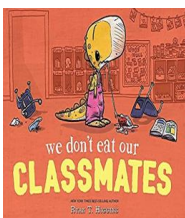
This interactive and playful story advises the reader on how to interact with a very shy dinosaur. Grades K-2.

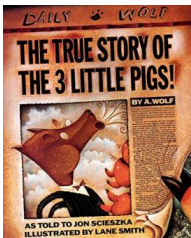
In this book with no pictures, the reader has to say every silly word, no matter what....Grades K-3.

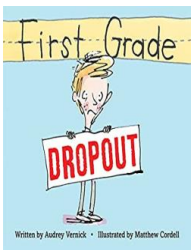
Follows a boy and his mouse through a busy day at school. Grades K-1.
